Workshops

In each workshop participants will experiment with and explore the processes described below. Resources and materials will be shared and demonstrated. Reflective practice is an essential aspect of each workshops.

Mixed media 3 hours
Making an art work on canvas or paper using a rich interplay of print, drawing and paint media.

Painting processes 3 hours
Making an art work using layering of colour, line and shape.

Conversations in paint 3 hours
Facilitating the beginning of figurative art processes.

Drawing 3 hours
An introduction to varieties of media and methods of observational drawing.

2 hour workshops are also available in Dance , Face painting, and Drama.

It is strongly recommend that all the staff or at least 2 people from a centre attend the workshops For Auckland centres cost is \$40 per person materials included

Discounts available for centres where all staff attend a workshop. This includes a follow-up visit to your centre.

For other areas of New Zealand the price of workshops is negotiable.
